Creating opportunities for a lifetime of learning.

Nurturing children and families in their mastery of reading skills and enjoyment of learning, the Library:

- Took on science in a big way during the *Fizz, Boom, Read* children's summer reading initiative and *Spark a Reaction* for young teens; 1,705 children and 416 teens signed-up.
- Partnered with IPTV to bring Martha Speaks and The Ruff Ruffman Show to family storytime; these special **early literacy** events attracted 93 children and 53 adults.
- Hosted 419 in-Library **programs** for children and presented 181 outreach programs with a total attendance of 13,512.

Developing the Library's materials collections for our unique community means staff:

- Cataloged, stamped, stickered, and readied 14,671 new books and recordings for public use and withdrew 16,873 outdated or damaged items.
- Manages 214,473 physical books and recordings in three locations.

Learners and leisure readers:

- Tallied a gate count of 344,375 patrons (234,720 Main; 84,226 Morningside; 25,429 Perry Creek).
- Borrowed 453,294 items. Systemwide **checkouts** are down 5.9% from last year.
- Found many new up-to-date titles in the areas of health, nature, wildlife, the environment, art and music thanks to completion of a *Reinvigoration of Library Collections for Community Betterment* project funded by a Gilchrist Foundation **grant**.

Inspiring a literate, engaged community.



Bringing readers together and building community, Library staff:

- Planned and presented the community-wide **One Book One Siouxland** reading initiative for *The Orphan Train*; 1,233 attended initiativesponsored events and hundreds more read and discussed the book in nonsponsored venues.
- Hosted monthly book discussion groups at the Morningside Branch and Perry Creek Branch Libraries.
- Supported reading at every age through **partnership events** and articles with the Humane Society, the Northwest Iowa Sierra Club, WITCC's Lifelong Learning Institute, retirement communities, and Siouxland Magazine among many.
- Collaborated with the Sioux City Musketeers to take a "Reading is Cool" message to schools, and partnered with the K-9 S.T.A.R.S to bring the Read-to-Me story dogs into Libraries to listen to **young readers**.
- Honored 118 **volunteers**, who donated 2,395 hours of service, with books placed in the Library's collection during April's National Volunteer Week.
- Improved local **reader advisor service** by creating a staff Reader Advisory Task force to lead and train all staff in the art of connecting readers with books.

The Library issued **5,444 new** library cards and purged **7,610 inactive** accounts.

- Checkouts of downloadable eBooks increased 40.9% over last year; a total of 11,518 eBook downloads, 5,327 eAudiobook downloads, and 2,690 music downloads.
- Twenty **new public-use computers** greeted patrons on February 23. Purchased with State of Iowa Direct Aid funds, these computers were installed with no service down time thanks to staff who helped at an afterhours installation party.
- **Morningside Branch** Library boasts a **fresh look** with new patron seating throughout (courtesy of Friends of the Library) and a rearranged children's book section for easier browsing.
- A new **digital film scanner** that saves and emails electronic copies of microfilmed newspaper stories and census records offers a boon to genealogists, local history buffs, and curious minds.
- Of the Library's 30,328 active card-holders, 16.5% used their cards to access online resources exclusively and did not check out any physical items.
- Sioux City Public Library continues to grow its fan base on Facebook, and is exploring ways to best reach potential followers through other **social platforms.**
- In 2014, the Library's **Facebook Page** celebrated a child's first library card and sent off long-time librarian, David Mook. We honored his 43 years of service to the Library by preparing a "Where's Dave?" photo-hunt game. Fans and followers were eager to participate and share their memories of Mr. Mook.
