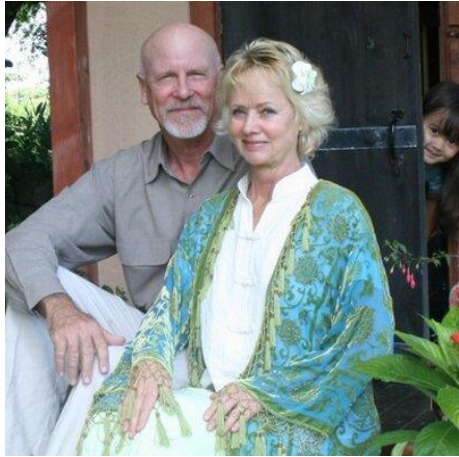

Early Literacy Tip
