#### **Tommy Thumbs**

## **Early Literacy Tip**

Callout bubbles (like in the Piggie and Elephant books) show us that a character is talking. Whenever you see that, that's what the bubble means. Adults, by pointing this out, you are showing your child a convention of print that will make is easier for them to understand how print works as they learn to read.
