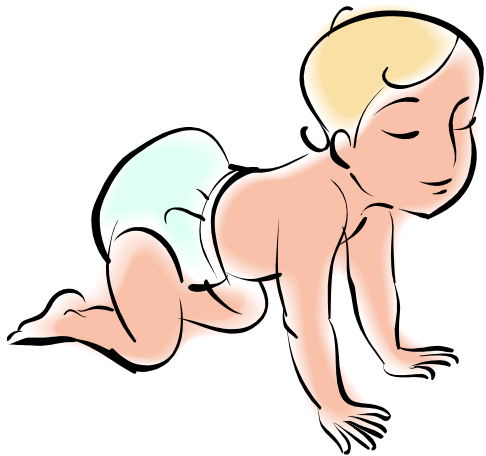

Cover him up so he won't peep.

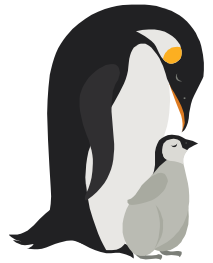
(wrap fingers around pointer finger)

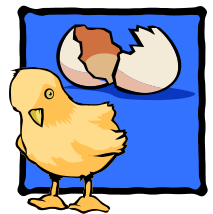
