**Do Your Ears Hang** 

Low?

Do your ears hang low? (flip hands down) Do they wobble to and fro? (wave hands side to side) Can you tie them in a knot? Can you tie them in a bow? (roll hands) Can you throw them over your shoulder like a continental soldier? (sling hands over a shoulder) Do your ears hang low? (flip hands down)

Do your ears hang high? (lift hands) Do they stand up in the sky? (hands up as high as they go) Do they drop down when they're wet? (hands down) Do they stand up when they're dry? (hands up) Do you wave them to your neighbor with a minimum of labor? (turn and wave to neighbor) Do your ears hang high? (hands up)

## Early Literacy Tip

Some children who don't like to listen to stories will be happy to listen to informational books. Ask at the library to see books on topics of interest to your children. You don't need to read all the words in these books, and you don't have to read them from cover to cover. Children see that books can be used for different purposes, which is an important aspect of background knowledge.
