## Activities

### Do Your Ears Hang Low?

Do your ears hang low?

(flip hands down)

Do they wobble to and fro?

(wave hands side to side)

Can you tie them in a knot?

Can you tie them in a bow?

(roll hands)

Can you throw them over your shoulder

like a continental soldier?

(sling hands over a shoulder)

Do your ears hang low?

(flip hands down)

Do your ears hang high?

(lift hands)

Do they stand up in the sky?

(hands up as high as they go)

Do they drop down when they're wet?

(hands down)

(hands up)

Do you wave them to your neighbor with a minimum of labor?

(hands up)
