Early Literacy Tip:

Books like Pumpkin Pumpkin help children see the order in which things take place. This helps them develop the mathematical concept of sequencing.

Retelling stories also helps children with sequencing. After you finish a book with your child, ask them to help you retell the story. Use words like "first," "then," and "finally" as you retell the story together.
