Early Literacy Tip

Narrative skills are the ability to retell stories and events. To help develop this skill, do a cumulative activity that builds on itself, like making a block tower, a snowman or stringing cheerios on yarn.

Talk about the process that you used, the order in which you did the activity. Say, "First we . . . , then we . . . , and finally we . . ." This will help your child remember how things happened in order.
