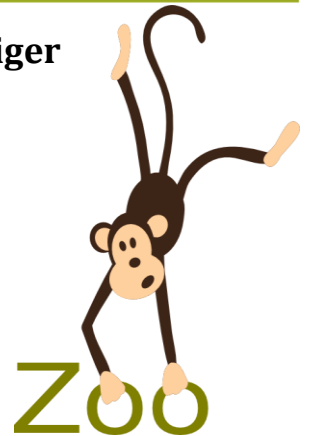

Early Literacy Tip



It takes longer for children who are just learning to talk to respond to our questions. This happens because four different parts of the brain have to work together for your child to form a response to what you say. **We need to be patient and wait anywhere from 5 to 12 seconds for children to respond when we ask a question.**
